First-time freediving

Enjoy your first dive in optimal conditions for an unforgettable experience. Supervised by qualified FFESSM instructors, and sometimes even by champions of the discipline, you will be guided step by step to explore your abilities in complete safety. These sessions are often an opportunity to surprise yourself: you will learn how it is possible to hold your breath for more than a minute... and come out feeling relaxed and proud! **Accessible without reservation.**

Introductory diving sessions for disabled people

Paris Dive Show is committed to inclusion by offering introductory dives specially adapted for people with disabilities. Supervised by trained and caring FFESSM instructors, this experience allows everyone to discover





the unique sensations of diving in a safe and reassuring environment. In a heated pool designed for easy access, participants are carefully guided at their own pace to enjoy a moment of pleasure, discovery, and personal achievement.

Discover target shooting

The Diving Show invites you to discover **an original and captivating discipline: underwater target shooting**. Accessible to young people and adults alike, this fun and technical activity promises thrills and spills. This sport combines concentration,

aquatic pleasure, and a friendly atmosphere. Supervised by enthusiastic instructors from the FFESSM and its Île-de-France Committee, you will be guided to improve with each shot... and hit your target in just a few attempts!

First dives with the French Navy

Every year, the French Navy recruits and trains scuba divers. Operating at depths of up to 50 meters, they are specialists in underwater work such as welding, assembling and cutting metal structures, and clearing port access routes. To discover **the world of this unique profession**, visit the French Navy stand to sign up for introductory dives. **Ongoing activity.**

Introductory dives with C.R.A.B.E, the French Navy's mine clearance diving apparatus.

The **CRABE Mark 2 (Complete Range Autonomous Breathing Equipment)** is a self-contained breathing apparatus designed for French Navy mine clearance divers. Non-magnetic and designed for use in sensitive environments, it can be used for operational dives at depths of 0 to 80 meters. If you want to step into the shoes of a mine clearance diver, don't miss this introductory session. **Permanent activity.**
