Beginners with no prior experiences can join our DSD program, and our experienced instructors will safely guide you under the water. (Available for ages 10 and above.)

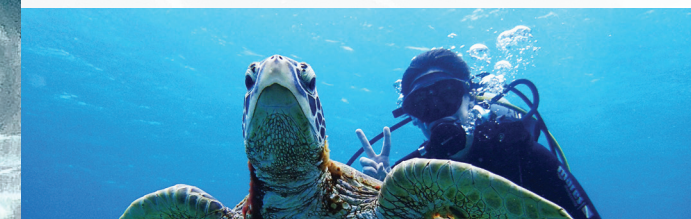

Boat (Dive cruise)

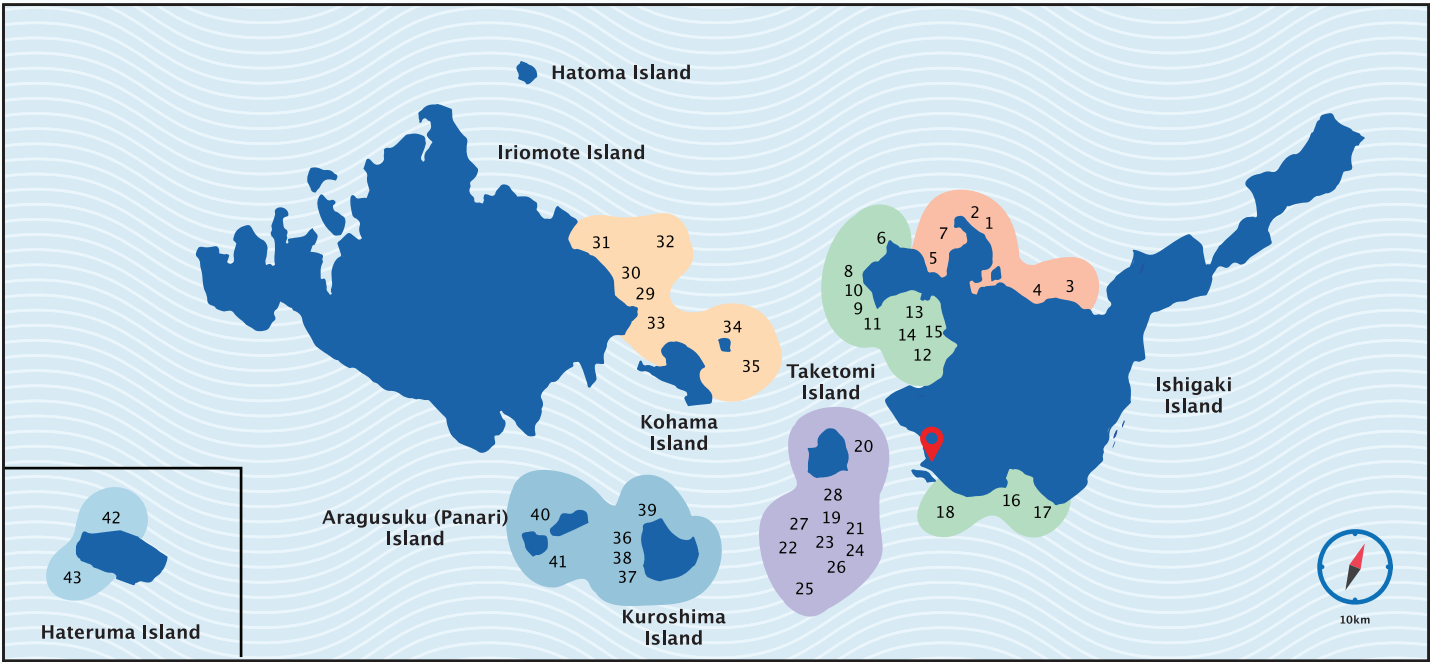

1 Manta Scramble
With multiple cleaning stations around the reef, this is a very popular diving spot to see manta rays.

Swimming through mystical arches as a beautiful curtain of sunlight dances towards the bottom.

A very cinematic dive point, where tons of luminous cardinalfish fill up the reef cracks in the summer.
