



VISITOR SANITARY PROTOCOL

Last update : June 25, 2021

The safety and health of its visitors remain a priority for the organization of the Paris International Dive Show.

We are closely monitoring the situation related to the coronavirus epidemic and are in permanent contact with the public authorities and event's professional associations.

The Paris International Dive Show will respect the sanitary protocol related to the context of the COVID 19 pandemic set up by the public authorities.

As the situation related to the spread of the coronavirus is evolving, the various actions carried out by the organization will be regularly updated according to government announcements.

The elements below concern the sanitary protocol applicable to events of more than 1000 people for the months of June and July 2021.

This sanitary protocol will be updated at the end of the summer for events in the last quarter of 2021. It will change many times between now and January 2022.

VISITOR SANITARY PROTOCOL

- Wearing a mask is mandatory from the age of 11. The mask must cover the nose, mouth and chin.
- The health pass is currently mandatory for access to major events. Available in paper and digital format, the health pass consists of presenting one of the following proofs of non-contamination:
 - ✓ Proof of a negative test less than 48 hours old (RT-PCR or antigenic test)
 - ✓ Vaccination certificate (full vaccination schedule)
 - ✓ Certificate of recovery of covid-19
